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Program Description

A. Plenary

A seminar or keynote presentation from a Math Professor who delivers key insight and allows students to ask questions.

B. Hands-on Activity

What in science called "lab". Here, the students have the opportunities to actively participate in doing things mathematical. For example, by creating things in workshops, playing various games (board, card, items, etc.). There will also be some mathemagics demonstration.

C. Games

As a break from the traditional written test competitions, here the students can participate in fun contests, where they are tested on speed and accuracy on not only mathematical problem solving, but also mathematical knowledge in general.

D. Final Round - FMC International 2025

The final round of the Factorial Math Camp will be attended by students who won Gold Medals in the Qualifying Rounds in each country.

E. Technical Meeting

Delivery of technical procedures for the final round exam, poster competition, and other activities.

F. Briefing

Explanation of the poster competition and announcement of poster groupings to students.

G. Poster Preparation

Time to work on posters with the group.

H. Poster Presentation

Presenting and explaining the poster to the Jury.

I. Awarding Ceremony

Announcement and medal presentation to the winners of the FMC Final Round

and the Poster Competition.

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Award Criteria

A. The FMC Final Round

The Champion, Runner-Up, 3rd Place. Special Awards (optional) in each level.

The number of Awards for the Final (International) Round depends on the total number of Participants. Maximum 50% of the total participants will be awarded.

B. The Poster Competition

The Best Poster in each level will be awarded.



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
